Very crisp, with citrus & peach fruit, hints of mineral  
(Australia) 2005 \$6

### Guenoc Chardonnay

Slightly creamy and dry; medium-bodied  
(California – Guenoc Valley) 2005 \$7.50

### Kendall Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay

Extremely creamy, oaky & buttery; full-bodied  
(California) 2005 \$8.00

### Thomas Fogarty Chardonnay

Oaky & buttery; full-bodied  
(California – Santa Cruz) 2003 \$12.25

### Pine Ridge

#### Chenin Blanc / Viognier

Crisp & slightly dry, but with tangy, rich fruit character  
(California - Clarksburg) 2005 \$8.50

### King Estate Pinot Gris

Dry & medium-bodied; lovely fruit  
(Oregon) 2005 \$7.50

Medium-bodied; juicy, ripe fruit flavors

Full-bodied; medium tannin; rich black fruit  
(California – Napa Valley) 2003 \$11.00

### Castle Rock Pinot Noir

Light-bodied; slightly earthy with ripe red fruit  
(California – Sonoma County) 2005 \$7.00

### King Estate Pinot Noir

Medium-bodied, Burgundian style, cranberry fruit  
(Oregon) 2004 \$13.75

### Hill of Content Shiraz

Medium to full-bodied; light spice; ripe fruit  
(Australia) 2004 \$7.50

### Manzanita Canyon

#### Cabernet Sauvignon

Full-bodied; dry; medium-full tannin; red fruit  
(California) 2005 \$5.50

### Pedroncelli – “Three Vineyards”

#### Cabernet Sauvignon

Full-bodied; dry; spice & oak; ripe black fruit  
(Dry Creek Valley - Sonoma) 2003 \$7.75

### Elderton Tantalus

(Shiraz / Cabernet Sauvignon / Malbec)

Medium-full bodied; extra ripe dark fruit; light tannin  
(Australia) 2004 \$8.00

### Caparzo Sangiovese

Light to medium-bodied; lively fruit; light tannin  
(Italy - Toscana) 2004 \$6.75

### E. Guigal Cotes du Rhone

(Syrah / Grenache / Mourvedre)

Medium-bodied; peppery; black fruit character; smooth tannins  
(France) 2003 \$8.00

### Murphy-Goode Zinfandel “Liar’s Dice”

Full-bodied, spicy pepper, very ripe black fruit  
(Sonoma County – California) 2004 \$9.75
